MPOR	RTANT REMINDERS				
1.	Do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery or the morning of surgery No breakfast – no water – no candy – no chewing gum. Nothing! The only exception may be certain medications which are written below.				
2.	You will need someone to drive you home after your surgery. If you intend to take a taxi, you sti must have someone with you. Your escort needs to be an adult (over 18 years old) who i physically able to assist you.				
3. 4.	Please arrange to have someone stay at your home with you for the first 24 hours after surgery.  Wear comfortable clothes. Appropriate clothing to wear after your operation might be				
5.	Leave jewelry and valuables at home. The hospital will provide a bathrobe, gown and slippers tuse while here.				
6.	Please remember to bring a case for contact lenses or eye glasses if you use these items needed, we will provide a denture cup.				
7.	If you normally wear make up, we ask that you wear a minimal amount on the day of surgery.				
8. 9.	Try to cut down or eliminate smoking for several days before surgery.  Bring all of your medications with you. We need to know what medications you take. Your doctor may want you to take some of your own pills before you go home.				
10. 11.	Remember to bring your insurance cards or forms with you.  If you have a cold, cough or do not feel well on the day of your surgery, please call your doctor
