- III. Severe systemic disease definite functional limitation
- IV. Severe systemic disease that is a constant threat to life
- V. Moribund patient not expected to survive 24 hours with or without operation
- E. Emergency

#### ALDRETE SCORE:

A score of 10 is required for discharge from post procedure area. For discharge with a score less than 10, a Doctor's specific order is required.

Cry	No cry (awake or asleep)	Moans or whimpers; occasional complaint

Each of the five categories (F) Face; (L) Legs; (A) Activity, (C) Cry; (C) Consolability is scored from 0-2, which results in a total score between zero and ten.
